CHAMPIONSHIP PERTINENT INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY: Entries are open to female amateur golfers who have reached their 50th birthday by April 26, 2010 and have a maximum handicap index of 30. Both partners must meet all eligibility requirements. Foreign contestants must meet similar requirements. Entries are subject to rejection at anytime.

ENTRIES, FORM AND FEES:

Entry Fee: \$360 per player / \$720 per team

Acceptance notifications will be made no later than March 18, 2010 at 5 p.m. EST. (Include an email address on your entry application for prompt acknowledgment of receipt of application.) 56 teams will be accepted into the championship. If more than 56 eligible teams have applied by March 18, the entry acceptances will be made to the lowest combined handicap teams and then by the date of entry receipt if there is a tie for the 56th team. All other entries will be placed on "standby" in order of total team handicap indexes and vacancies will be filled in that order. Late entries will be accepted and either added to the 'standby' list or entered in the championship if the field is not full.

ENTRIES MAY BE SUBMITTED INDIVIDUALLY OR AS A TEAM.

If submitted individually, each player MUST list her partner's name and team acceptance will be determined when both individual applications have been received and matched up by the Entry Director. Online entries: The process of entering online has changed. The Trans will be using PayPal as our official credit card processor. PayPal provides us improved security that is important to you and to the Trans. Follow the instructions detailed in the online process, **OR** you may print out the application forms and submit by US Postal mail; the acknowledgment date will be the date received by the Entry Director. Email addresses are essential in order to resolve any issues with the applications and for notification of receipt/acceptance.

A player may substitute a partner at any time prior to April 26 provided the submitted player meets all eligibility requirements. Following March 18, all cancellations will be subject to a \$25 service charge per player. Cancellations between April 11 and April 25 will only be considered for refund if the reason is illness or injury and a doctor's report is submitted with request.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT: Format will be 54-hole four-ball stroke play (Rule 31) in which two competitors play as partners, each playing her own ball. The lower score of the partners is the score for the hole. Each day will consist of an 18 hole round. All teams will qualify for flights based on their 36 hole total score. The committee will determine the number of teams per flight after qualifying rounds.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Monday, April 26, is the official practice day for the TRANS Senior Four-Ball Championship. Starting times for practice rounds may be made by calling the Quarry Pro Shop (210) 824-4500 30 days in advance (March 27 through April 25). Additional practice rounds with golf cart will be available at a rate of \$50 per player. Please identify yourself as a TRANS contestant.

PUBLICITY, PROMOTION and BROADCASTING: The TRANS may arrange for promotion of this Championship for radio, television, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of this Championship, including the TRANS Website. By this application, the player consents to the use by the TRANS, or persons authorized by the TRANS of her name, likeness, voice and references to her and photographs and other images of her and her play connected with her appearance in this Championship or any portion(s) thereof, in connection with such media promotion, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of this Championship.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: The low gross team will be presented THE WILMA CUP perpetual trophy to remain in their possession for one year. The CUP is actually two beautiful antique silver vases donated in honor of Wilma Gilliland in recognition of her many years of dedicated support and commitment to WTNGA.

The low gross team after 36 holes qualifying will receive the LUCILE ROBINSON MANN perpetual award donated by the TRANS 1941 Champion, Lucile Mann. This lovely sterling silver tray was presented to Mrs. Mann by the Women's TRANS National Golf Association in honor of her victory.

First, second and third low gross teams in each flight will receive a prize.

TRANSPORTATION: Most major airlines service San Antonio, Texas. Transportation is via taxi cab to downtown for approximately \$25 (multiple passengers can split the fare) or city bus. Hotel shuttle service is not available. Rental cars are available at the airport. The Quarry Golf Club is located only a few minutes from the airport.

REGISTRATION: (All times are Central Daylight Time) All players must register in person between 8 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. CDT on April 26, 2010 or notify the Trans Entry Director, Tina Sanders, by phone or letter of arrival time and intention to play. After April 24, 2010, call Tina Sanders on her cell phone. Place may be forfeited by a player when no response is received by April 26, 2010. Non-contestant fees will be collected at registration for any player's guest(s) who wish to attend the social functions.
